## School Fee Regulations

These fees are effective from 1 December 2019, and shall remain in force until changed by the Board of Governors. Whilst it is the aim of the Board to set fees on an annual basis, the Board reserves the right to change these at any time. Parents agree to be bound by the School's schedule of fees and charges. The School reserves the right to refuse continued enrolment at the School if the applicable fees are not paid in full by the specified due date. All school account payments must be up to date before a student is permitted to attend any non curriculum trips, camps or excursions for which a charge is levied.

## Election of Payment Method

For triannual or monthly instalments, a payment method must be elected by Friday 7 February 2020 via the Synergetic Parent Portal. If this does not occur, payments will be due monthly by default.

<b>In Person</b>	Payment can be made in person by cash, cheque or credit card at either the Junior or Secondary Campus Reception. Please note, payments made in person by credit card will attract a 1.25% surcharge.

## Sibling Discount

For families with more than one child attending the School at the same time, discount is applied to that child's tuition fees at the following rates:

- Second Child 12.5%
- Third Child 30%
- Fourth & Subsequent Child 100%

## Fees in Advance Discount

Annual tuition fees for the current year will attract a discount of 3.5% when payment in full is made by 24 January 2020.

Payment of tuition fees for future years can also be made at the current fee levels, at anytime prior to the ratification of the following year's fees.

## Late Payment

A late payment charge will be imposed if payment of school fees and charges are not made by the agreed due date(s), or in the absence of other arrangements.

The late payment charge will be set at the interest rate and margin applicable to the School's Business Offset loan account plus an administration charge relating to the Finance Officer's time. The late payment charge will be calculated daily from the due date of payment, until payment of outstanding fees is made.

## St John's Grammar Foundation

On each account, a donation of \$250 per family towards the School's Foundation is shown. This is a voluntary, tax deductible sum.

## Composite Fee

This fee covers resources and consumables used inside and outside the classroom including:

- Library resources
- Physical Education resources
- Art resources
- Information technology infrastructure
- Camps and excursions (excluding Years 5 & 6)
- School scarf and Retreat (Year 12 only)

## Technology Levy (Years 4 – 7)

The levy covers the supply and support of a technological learning device – the HP ProBook x360 Notebook PC.

## Book Hire & Licensing Fee

This fee covers full year use of text books and e-learning resources by Secondary students. This charge represents a substantial discount to the purchase of required texts and e-learning licences. The replacement cost of text books badly damaged or unreturned at the end of the school year will be charged to the student's School Account.

## Old Scholars' Association Lifetime Membership

This \$250 fee is applied to the account of all Year 12s, and includes lifetime membership for that student to the St John's Grammar School Old Scholars' Association.

## Other Charges

Additional charges may be applied to the school account for non compulsory or elective courses or activities, including but not limited to:

- Music instrument hire, bond and tuition
- Tech Studies/Art materials (elective projects)
- Year 5 and 6 camps
- Year 10 *Explore & Soar* week activities
- Ski Trip
- Year 12 Study Guides
- Travel Insurance (if applicable)
- Year 12 & Year 6 Jumpers
- Out of School Hours Care and Vacation Care

These charges will be published on the Synergetic Payment Portal

## Holding Fee

This fee allows a student's place at the School to be held if the student needs to be absent for five weeks or longer. In turn, parents are required to give at least five weeks written notice addressed to the Principal for a change in enrolment status.

## Notice of Withdrawal

A full Term's notice must be given in writing to advise that a student will be withdrawing from the School. If this notice is not given, one Term's fees will be payable in lieu of notice.
