TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE SALE OF SECONDHAND UNIFORM

- Secondhand uniform is accepted on a consignment basis and sales are processed twice per term. Once goods are sold, 80% of the purchase price will be credited to your nominated bank account. The St John's Grammar Parents & Friends Association (P&F) will retain 20% of the purchase price (effective 1 July 2021). All proceeds are returned to the school for community building initiatives.
- You may choose to donate 100% of the proceeds of the sale of your secondhand uniform to the P&F. Donations are gratefully accepted and <u>all proceeds are returned to the school for community building initiatives.</u>
- Please complete the Secondhand Uniform Deposit Form with your signature and date and leave it with the garments you would like us to sell for you. The Secondhand Uniform form can be downloaded from the St John's Grammar Parents & Friends Association site, https://stjohnspandf.org.au or collected from the Secondhand Uniform Shop. Secondhand garments may be left at the Secondhand Uniform Shop during openings or at the school's Junior and Secondary Front Offices.
- Please ensure that all garments are <u>freshly laundered</u> and blazers are dry-cleaned. The
 Uniform Shop <u>does not</u> accept Year 12 specific uniform, socks, bike shorts or discontinued
 uniform.
- We will not accept any garments that are: faded; stained; have frayed cuffs, collars and hems, holes, worn knees, obvious repairs or alterations, brands not sold at uniform shop; superseded items of uniforms. A good way to judge is to send garments that you would be happy to purchase.
- The St John's Grammar Parents & Friends Association reserves the right to dispose of any garments considered unsuitable for sale.
- Secondhand Uniform Shop volunteers keep a close eye on the stock available for sale. If your items have not sold within 12 months, and we suspect they are unlikely to sell, we reserve the right to remove them from the shelves and dispose of them. You may request an update of your items at any time and are welcome to retrieve unsold items to sell privately if you wish.
