

# General Excellence Scholarship

## Fact Sheet – 2025 entry



St John's Grammar School offers limited General Excellence Scholarships to students not currently attending the Secondary School, entering into Years 7 – 12 in 2025. Students currently attending St John's Grammar Junior School who will enter the Middle School in 2025 are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

### General Excellence Scholarship Criteria

Students applying for a General Excellence Scholarship should be able to demonstrate enthusiasm, participation and exceptional commitment in a diverse range of activities, which may include:

- Community involvement
- Leadership
- Extra-curricular involvement
- Persistence in academic pursuits

### A successful General Excellence Scholarship student will be expected to:

- Be a role model to other students
- Be a team player in all pursuits
- Contribute to School life and inspire others

### Application Process

Selection for the General Excellence Scholarship will be by interview, referees and recent school reports.

Application forms must be completed and submitted prior to the closing date.

A letter written by the applicant, together with the contact details of two referees, addressed to the Principal, should accompany the Application Form.

Short-listed candidates will subsequently be invited to attend a short interview with the Principal and another teacher, usually the Head of Middle or Senior School, as appropriate.

### Useful Information

- Applicants may like to submit evidence of their ability to meet the Selection Criteria as part of the application process. For example:
  - Academic achievements such as NAPLAN Test Results
  - School reports
  - Achievements, certificates or awards demonstrating achievement or participation in academic or
  - co-curricular activities
  - Evidence of participation or involvement in the community, such as volunteering, charity work, groups or clubs
  - Evidence of leadership roles within current school or community
  - Any other relevant documents in support of the application

*Copies of the above are sufficient.*
