

# Scholarship of St John

(Gordon Hewitson Memorial Scholarship)

## Fact Sheet – 2025 entry



St John's Grammar School is currently offering limited Scholarships of St John to students not currently attending the School, entering into Reception – Year 12 in 2025.

### Scholarship of St John Criteria

This scholarship offers an opportunity to provide a St John's Grammar School education to a family who may otherwise not be able to afford one.

A Scholarship of St John will be considered for families based on their long-term financial situation and/or short-term hardship criteria.

As an example, St John is the patron saint of hospitals and the sick. A family who has been impacted by family illness or other situation beyond their control would be given consideration.

### A successful Scholarship of St John student will be expected to:

- Be a role model to other students
- Be a team player in all pursuits
- Contribute to School life and inspire others

### Application Process

Selection for the Scholarship of St John will be different for each family, and will involve a comprehensive review of each family's situation and subsequent interview with the student(s).

Application forms must be completed and submitted prior to the closing date along with completion of the required financial documentation.

A letter to the Principal, written by the applicant, outlining why they are applying should accompany the Application Form.

Applicants will subsequently be invited to attend a short confidential meeting with the Principal.

### Useful Information

- Applicants may like to submit evidence of their ability to meet the Selection Criteria as part of the application process. For example:
  - Academic achievements such as NAPLAN Test Results
  - School reports
  - Achievements, certificates or awards demonstrating achievement or participation in academic or
  - co-curricular activities
  - Evidence of participation or involvement in the community, such as volunteering, charity work, groups or clubs
  - Evidence of leadership roles within current school or community
  - Any other relevant documents in support of the application

*Copies of the above are sufficient.*
